



Local Rules

1. **Out of Bounds** (Rule 27-1) All gardens, clubhouse grounds and Car Parks. Players may not enter private property in search of balls. 1st Hole. Road on right of fairway and all beyond it. 6th Hole. Beyond the fence at the back of the green. 18th Hole. Beyond the white stakes.
2. **Stones** in bunkers are moveable obstructions. (Rule 24-1)
3. **Ground under repair.** (Rule 25-1) A ball lying within an area marked as GUR must be lifted a dropped dropped without penalty within one club length, not nearer the hole.
4. If a ball stikes a power line during play of the 8th Hole, the stroke is cancelled and the player must play a ball from as near as possible to the spot from which the original ball was played in accordance with Rule 20-5.
5. **Lateral Water Hazards** (Red Stakes) The ditches at the 8th, 9th, 11th and 13th Holes between the marker posts. Yellow stakes define water hazards.
6. The wire netting structures at the 1st, 14th and 15th Holes are immoveable obstructions (Rule 24-2)
7. All roads, pavements and artificially surfaced paths within the confines of the Course are obstructions and relief may be taken (Rule 24-2)
8. A ball lying on a re-seeded divot **MUST** be lifted and dropped without penalty within one club length, not nearer the hole.
9. **Distance Measuring Devices.** For all play at this course a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (eg gradient, windspeed, temperature etc.), the player is in breach of rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

Penalty for breach of Local Rule, (unless otherwise specified),

Stroke Play – 2 Shots

Match Play – Loss of Hole

All golfers must give right of way to vehicles and Pedestrians on Public Roads crossing the 1st and 15th holes. Also on Public Footpaths on 7th and 8th Holes.
